# **GBDeflicker4 Known Issues**

- Do not use GBDeflicker4 with time remapping or time reverse.
- Premiere Pro: When dragging sub-rectangle corners the image isn't marked as needing to be analyzed. This is due to a bug in Premiere Pro.
- After Effects CC 2015 version 13.5 has a bug that prevents using the GBDeflicker4 effect more than once on a layer. Adobe released After Effects 13.5.1 fixing this problem in July of 2015.
